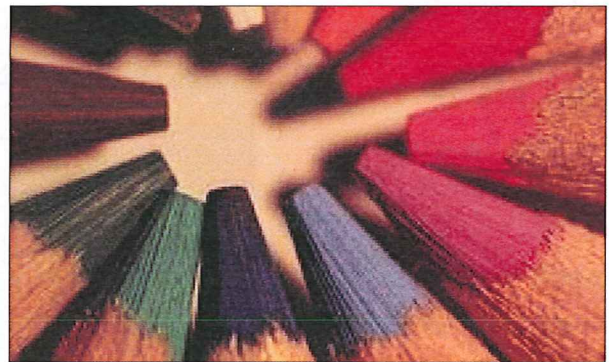

ous mediums will be displayed such as wood carvings and embroidery. A new artist reception will be held on Tuesday, evening, February 7, at 7:00. Spend

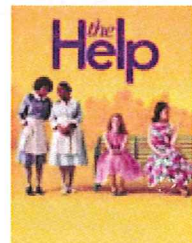
an evening enjoying refreshments, the company of good friends, and what promises to be a most interesting art display at Vista's Furnival Gallery.

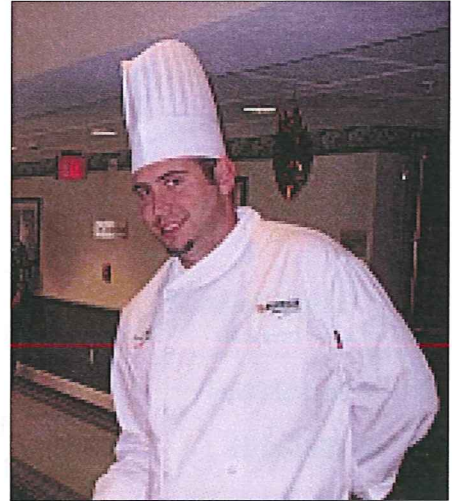
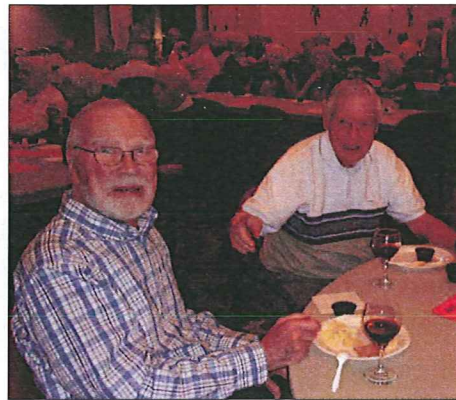

## WARM UP WITH BAKED OATMEAL

- 1 Large egg, beaten
- 1.5 tsp Baking Powder
- 1/3 c Oil
- 1/5 tsp Salt
- 1/2 c Brown Sugar
- 3/4 c Milk
- Cinnamon
